VINEYARDS / WINEMAKING:

Our Chardonnay is a blend of two local vineyards in close proximity to our historic Wohler Bridge. The Foppoli Vineyard makes up 60% of the blend and is located on Slusser Road next to Sonoma Cutrer and La Crema. Completing the blend is Syre Vineyard at 40%, which is just east of us on Westside Road. Using native yeast, we fermented and aged the wine in one-third stainless steel and two-thirds oak barrels for nine months.

TASTING NOTES:

Sublimely balanced with aromas of pear, gardenia, passion fruit, pineapple and delicate minerality. Juicy and slightly creamy with bright fruit and just whisper of toast and vanilla.
